



## Red Cliffs Lodge Horseback Trail Ride Adventures 2017

Ride the country made famous by John Wayne. Our trails run along and across Castle Creek several times. You'll view the Colorado River, world famous Castle Rock, and the La Sal Mountains from the high desert trail. Wildlife like deer, wild turkeys, and smaller animals are commonly seen. Our horses are cowboy-trained and our tack is new and well maintained. You'll be accompanied by experienced, friendly, professional wranglers who will help you learn on your ride and, of course, your safety is always our top priority.

You will be picked up at the lodge by your professional wrangler in a ranch truck pulling a horse trailer with your cowboy-trained Quarter Horse inside. A short distance, from the lodge we will unload and ride off into the high Utah desert. This wide-open range is the same scenic country used in the background of many famous movies and hundreds of commercials.

The trails wind through washes, over and along ridge tops with fantastic views of the big valley below, the Colorado River, huge sandstone rock formations—such as the Priest and the Nuns and Castle Rock—and the La Sal Mountains in the distance. You'll ride among native desert trees and bushes and it's possible to see large wild animals such as mule deer. The group will stop for great photo opportunities. Once back at the truck, we'll load up and return to Red Cliffs Lodge in time for the optional BBQ lunch served on the Red Cliffs Lodge River Deck.

The group size is limited to ensure everyone can hear the information our wranglers provide about the area and horsemanship instructions.

**General information:**

- All participants—or their guardian—must sign an accident-liability waiver before riding.
- Return times are approximate and depend upon the size of group and riding conditions.
- There is a 16-rider group limit for safety and to ensure great ride quality.
- There is a 10-year age minimum or 52" height requirement.
- There is a 220 lb. weight limit.
- The Red Cliffs Lodge trail ride is a little more strenuous than some others so riders must be in good physical condition without any special needs or limitation.
- Appropriate dress includes long pants, sturdy shoes with closed toes, and a jacket as needed for inclement weather.
- Retrieving fallen hats can be dangerous. If you wear a hat it must be snug fitting or have a string to keep it on your head in case of wind.
- No backpacks or purses are permitted on the ride. A small saddlebag is provided for sunscreen, water, compact camera, and small snacks such as a candy bar.
